Georginna Lockett-Wright, a native of Macon, Georgia enrolled at Tuskegee University on a four-year academic scholarship in 2000. Lockett Wright walked-on as a freshman and started six games for the Lady Tigerette Basketball team. She lettered four years as a continuous starter. She was selected to the AII-SIAC academic conference team in 2004, served as Co-Captain from 2001-2004 and had the highest G.P.A. on the team all four-years. Lockett-Wright played Semi Pro basketball for the Lady Knights from 2007-2009 in Atlanta.

Lockett-Wright earned a Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering from Tuskegee and was on the Dean's List every semester. She was the Vice President of Omega Chi Epsilon, a member of Beta Kappa Chi, National Society of Black Engineers and Women in Engineering, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, American Institute of Chemical Engineers-Georgia Club, and Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. She continued her education and earned a M.B.A. at DeVry Univ., MEd at Jones International Univ., and an Assoc. Degree in Funeral Services from St. Petersburg College.

Lockett-Wright's professional career began with Weyerhaeuser in N.C. as a Process Engineer, where she learned water treatment. She progressively mastered the field and earned a rewarding job as the Plant Manager of the Chattahoochee Water Treatment Plant in Atlanta, which provides safe drinking water to over 1 million customers. Additionally, Lockett-Wright started a nonprofit "Divine Success" in 2007 and has been educating children and youth, mentoring teenagers, and providing scholarships and community services opportunities.
