



**Dr. Sidney L. Brown**

Dr. Sidney L. Brown, a native of Tuskegee, Alabama, enrolled in Tuskegee University after transferring from Mississippi Valley State. Dr. Brown's transfer to Tuskegee University had an immediate impact as the team's record improved from 1-10 to 8-2 in a single season. A consistent SIAC All Conference/All Academic performer and 3-year starter, Brown led a stingy Tuskegee defense to a shared SIAC conference title. He was named Team Captain during his junior and senior seasons, and earned Player of the Week Honors on numerous occasions, all while repeatedly maintaining a spot on the Dean's List.

Dr. Brown earned a B.S. degree in Agribusiness Education from Tuskegee in 1987. He subsequently obtained a Master's Degree from Alabama A & M University and his Doctorate of Philosophy at Iowa State University.

Dr. Brown's professional accomplishments include being a highly sought after educator, principal, administrative specialist, author, and pending playwright of "Some Lessons Have to be Learned", a non-fiction memoir on the rise and fall of race, class, education, politics and its impact on the demise of Black America. In addition to serving as State and Regional Past Presidents of the Educational Administration Professor Association, Brown is the current TUNAA Vice-Chair for Finance. Dr. Brown was selected as Who's Who Teacher of the Year nine times during his illustrious career, becoming the youngest tenured full-professor at Alabama State University before retiring from Auburn University Montgomery.

Dr. Brown is a Deacon at Dexter Avenue King Memorial Baptist Church in Montgomery and was once named Volunteer of the Year for the Boys & Girls Clubs of Alabama. He is the recipient of the 2019 TNAA Southeast Region Alumni of the Year Award; and is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity.

Dr. Brown is a consistent and generous supporter of his Alma mater and Tuskegee Athletics, an Eminent Scholar, and member of the Tuskegee Alumni Club. He frequently refers hundreds of students to Tuskegee for matriculation.

Dr. Sidney L. Brown is the father of two adult sons, a beautiful daughter in law, and two gorgeous granddaughters.
