Harrell W. Moore, Atlanta, Georgia, was a member of the Football Team, 1959-1962 and the Baseball Team 1960 to 1963. Many of his historic feats were made on the gridiron. He was the most valuable player on Tuskegee's Teams in 1961 and 1962. The Campus Digest often referred to him as the gallaping ghost of the south as he led his team in rushing for three years and shattered many SIAC records in total offense. After receiving many team and conference honors, he was selected to the Pittsburg Courier

All-American Team in 1961.

As manager of the J. C. Penney Catalog Division, he continues to be of service to his community as a participant in the guide right program of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity. Forest Park Jaycees, Tuskegee Alumni Association and the Tuskegee University National Athletic Association.
