

FRANK E. SIMMONS Class of 1950 (posthumously)

"In the middle of the line will be Frank Simmons, a 205 Freshman", "Tuskegee will average more due to the presence of this oversize center in the lineup." - Sports Writer. This electrifying multi-dimensional athlete from Beach High School, Savannah, Georgia claimed a Golden Tiger Uniform and wore it well. His exceptional talents were displayed in track, baseball and football, bringing him recognition as "All American" in 1946.

Frank Simmons, one of Tuskegee's most outstanding atheltes, has been enshrined in the Beach High Athletic Hall of Fame and the Greater Savannah Athletic Hall of Fame. He earned All European as a player - coach while in service as an officer in Germany and received several citations for contributions he made toward the development of athletics and enhancement of sportsmanship for underprivileged boys.

As a professional, he was an outstanding teacher, coach, and role model serving in many capacities; helping youngsters grow and develop into exceptional young men and women. For many years, he was a volunteer coach, athletic official and counselor at the Frank Callen Boys Club of Savannah.
