Pernell Miller, outstanding athlete, educator and humanitarian. Playing under the direction and guidance of Coach Cleve Abbott and Coach Edward Adams, Pernell Miller lettered in three sports, football, basketball and baseball. An All American in 1945 and a member of the 1946 championship SIAC Baseball Team, Pernell graduated from Tuskegee in 1946.

Married and the father of four boys and two girls, Pernell continued in sports as a coach, working at Palmetto Senior High School and Northwestern High School in Miami, Florida after two years in the United States Army. He retired from Northwestern in 1992. With six State Championships in baseball and three in football, he feels his outstanding contribution is influencing his former students to attend college, particularly Tuskegee.

A member of the St. James Episcopal Church of Perry, Florida, Pernell is also active in American Legion and the Boys and Girls Club.
