Arthur L. Brown, a native of Jackson, Mississippi, was an athletic rarity around Brinkley High School, lettering in football, basketball, track & field, and baseball. At Tuskegee, he started, lettered, and labored at the fullback position for the Golden Tigers for four consecutive years from 1965 thru 1969. He finished with a 3.6 yard per carry college career rushing average. He was a member of the 1967 and 1968 S.I.A.C. Football Championship teams. Art also lettered in Track & Field, participating in the 120 High Hurdles, 400 Intermediate Low Hurdles, Discus Throw, Shot Put, Javelin Throw, and the Long Jump. Art pledged Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. in the spring of 1968. He signed a free agent contract with the Kansas City Chiefs of the National Football League at the completion of his college career at Tuskegee in 1969.

Art earned a B.S. degree in Physical Education from Tuskegee Institute in 1969. He earned three M.S. ED. Degrees at Jackson State University in Physical Education, Health Education, and General Science.

Art was Honorary Recipient of Strathmore's Who's Who, Who's Who Among America's Teachers in 1992, and Who's Who in American Education in 1992. He served in the U.S. Army as a CID Special Agent for 28 years and 3 months before retiring as a reservist/active duty soldier. He was a teacher, coach and recreational supervisor at Oakley Training School in Raymond, Mississippi; a coach at Jim Hill High School in Jackson, Mississippi; Assistant Principal at Madison Central High School in Canton, Mississippi; a coach at LaMarque Middle School in LaMarque, Texas; and a coach at Vigor High School in Prichard, Alabama.

Art is a member of many professional, community, and service organizations including Epsilon Kappa Kappa Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. and Brinkley High School Alumni Association.

Art is a strong and consistent supporter of Tuskegee University. He is currently the President of the Jackson-Tuskegee Alumni Club in Jackson, Mississippi and the Executive Director of the Tuskegee Golden Tigers National Athletic Association.

Art resides in Jackson, Mississippi.
