HOF NOMINATIONS

Nomination Description: Nominations for induction are accepted thru out the year, all nominations must be submitted prior to **January 1** of the induction year. Inductions are held during the fall of odd years usually during the month of September.

Who can nominate candidate? Nominations can be made by Hall of Fame Members; Tuskegee University Alumni; Tuskegee University Alumni Clubs; any individual knowledgeable about the candidate's achievements; or the candidate.

Rating Category: Nominees for induction into the Tuskegee University Athletic Hall of Fame will be evaluated on the following categories:

- ✓ Made exceptional contributions to Tuskegee sport(s) they are being nominated.
- ✓ Graduate of Tuskegee University or graduate of some other university (4-year degree) for at least 10 years prior to nomination.
- ✓ Direct, consistent and current financial support to Tuskegee University within 5 years prior to the submission of nomination.

Selection Process: TUAHOF Nomination & Selection Committee utilizes a 100 point-based rating system. Nominee must earn points in each category and must have a rating of 89-100 to qualify for induction.

HOF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Description: TUAHOF Scholarship is available to Tuskegee University student-athletes who demonstrates academic and athletic achievement. Applications available in **August**.

Award(s): Two recipients (one female and one male), \$2500.00 each per year

Selection Criteria: Applicants will be rated and selected based on the following:

- ✓ Full-time sophomore, junior, or senior Tuskegee University student-athlete
- ✓ Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.7 or higher
- ✓ Enrolled at Tuskegee University as a full-time student during the current semester
- ✓ Volunteer at least 25 hours per school year
- ✓ Submit a one-page typewritten essay

Selection Process: Tuskegee Univ. Athletics Academic review applications and select students based on a rubric scoring system.

We are the fruition of our parents' biggest dreams. As hardworking farmers, they were able to put all five of us through Tuskegee (Institute) University.


