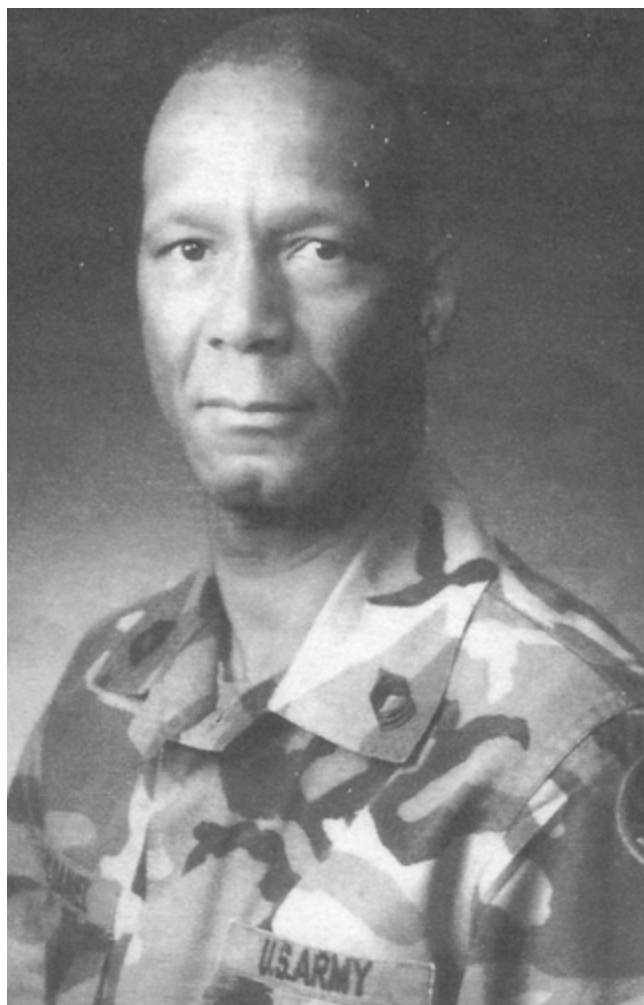

Ernie James Montgomery

Class of 1969

Ernie Montgomery is a native of Montgomery, Alabama. He enrolled at Tuskegee Institute in 1965. As a freshman, he became the team manager for the Men's Basketball team under Coach O.J. Catlin. During his sophomore year, he was the team scorekeeper for the basketball and football teams under Coach Leroy Smith. Throughout the three years of basketball, he earned the letter "T" award (1965-66), the sweater (1966-67) and the jacket (1967-68) as manager and scorekeeper, in association with football as team statistician. Ernie's awards also include SIAC Coach of the year 1973, 1974, 1975 for Cross Country. He served as the assistant director of the NYSP under Director Dr. H. Frank Leftwich.

Academically, he earned a BS in Physical Education from Tuskegee Institute (1969), a MA in Physical Education from Ball State University (1971), and a second BS in Physical Therapy (1985) from Florida A& M University. Additional studies were done in Supervision and Administration at Tuskegee Institute during the summers of 1977 and 1978.

Montgomery began his professional career at Tuskegee Institute in 1969-70 as a teaching assistant in Physical Education. He returned from Ball State to Tuskegee Institute as a full-time instructor of Health, Physical Education and Recreation (1971-1979). After receiving a BS in Physical Therapy his professional career made a transition to clinical physical therapy until his retirement in 2015.

Currently, he is a member of the Tuskegee National Alumni Association (TNAA), Montgomery-Tuskegee Alumni Club, Life Member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc. and a member of First C.M.E. Church, Montgomery, AL.

Ernie's community involvement includes serving on the Board of Directors of the Cleveland Avenue Branch of Montgomery YMCA, volunteering with the YMCA tennis clinic and the annual golf and tennis tournament for the Boys & Girls club.

Financial support is given annually through donations to the Tuskegee University Scholarship Fund.

Ernie resides in Montgomery with his wife, Valda. He has an extended family of five children, eight grandchildren, and most recently three great-grandsons.



Edwin Jay Grimmatt

Class of 1979

Edwin Jay Grimmatt, a native of Sylacauga, Alabama entered Tuskegee University in 1970 on a four-year football scholarship as a quarterback. Jay was immediately tasked to install the high-powered offense of New Tuskegee coach, *Haywood Scissum*. Jay lettered all four years while at Tuskegee and was named Comeback Player of the Year his senior year after recovering from a knee injury.

Jay served in the Alabama Army National Guard and would eventually satisfy his military obligation on active duty. He completed his BS in Physical Education, and a master's degree in Special Education (ED) at Tuskegee.

Jay began his twenty-year coaching career as an assistant at Tuskegee, coaching quarterbacks and receivers. These athletes called themselves the "T-Birds". Many of his athletes are enshrined in the TUAHOF. Jay also coached football and track for 18 years, coaching quarterbacks, and as offensive coordinator and athletic director. His track teams won three regional championships and one runner-up. His 1992 track team finished 3rd in the state with only six athletes. Grimmatt was a high school assistant principal before being named middle school principal of a Title One school. Grimmatt's school would become a *state school of excellence* under his leadership. He opened a new middle school in 2002. His school would receive a *national honor* as a "*Lighthouse School to Watch*". Jay served as chairman of numerous SACs Accreditation teams throughout the state. Grimmatt retired from the Douglas County, GA School System.

Grimmatt's community involvement is expansive: Life Member of Georgia Association of Educators, member National Education Association, manager of a voting precinct, volunteer marshal at the FedEx Cup Golf Championship, superintendent of Sunday school, member of the Board of Directors for the Boys and Girls Club, Douglasville, GA.

Grimmatt is a consistent contributor to Tuskegee University via: The 1881 Project, Annual General Donations, TASS Golf tournaments at homecoming and classics, Skegee Golden Tiger, Inc., and a member of the Atlanta Tuskegee Alumni Club.

Grimmatt and his wife, Ernestine of 49 years, reside in Winston, GA, and they have two sons, and three grandsons.



Sophia A. James Hall

Class of 1980

Sophia James Hall, a native of Miami, Florida enrolled at Tuskegee Institute on a four-year Volleyball Scholarship in August of 1976. Along with her twin sister Sonia James, she was a member of the 1977 SIAC Volleyball Championship team.

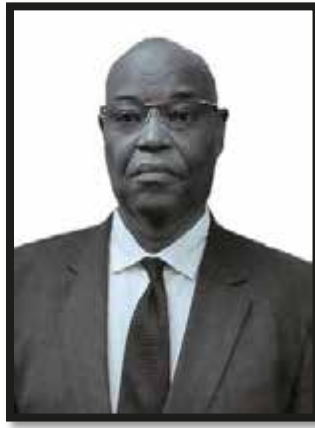
Sophia was a Physical Education major at Tuskegee and graduated in the Class of 1980. She was active on campus holding a position in her dormitory, Adams Hall and ran for Miss Tuskegee. Sophia also appeared in an article of The Campus Digest because of her uniqueness of being an identical twin. She pledged Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Inc. Upon graduating she subsequently earned a Master of Science in Educational Leadership at Nova University in 1986.

Ms. Hall had a drive to succeed. She was the consummate educator who soared in her field. She began as a classroom teacher who excelled to the ranks of Assistant Principal and Vice Principal in the Miami Dade County Public Schools. She was named Teacher of the Year in 1995 and was a finalist in 2013 for Assistant Principal of the Year in Technical/ Alternative and Community Education. The graduation rate at William H. Turner Technical School skyrocketed under her leadership.

Sophia was affiliated and actively involved with many community, social and spiritual organizations. She was a member of Mount Calvary Missionary Baptist Church and North Miami Education Board. She worked tirelessly with the homeless, continuing education programs at the Miami Rescue Mission, Lotus House, along with many other shelters. She was also School Administrator of Miami Dade Corrections, assisting inmates in transitioning. Ms. Hall was President of Miami Jackson Alumni Class of 1976.

Sophia was an individual who loved Tuskegee. She was a supporter of the Tuskegee University Scholarship Fund and the South Florida Tuskegee Alumni Club.

Ms. Hall passed away in Miami, Florida on June 18, 2020. Leaving behind her beloved family; Donald James Sr. (Brother), Senella Clinch, Sonia James and Linda Woods (Sisters), Courtney Hall, Shonta James and Shanreeka Hall (Children), Kaziyah Hall, Jordan Pastora, Jaida Pastora, Jaylen Suarez, Janae Suarez, Jazmin Sanudo, Issac Shepherd, Semaj Wilson and Journee Hall (Grandchildren).



Alfred "Teddy" Ogden
Class 1983

Alfred Ogden was born in Baxley Georgia and started his educational journey in Savannah, Ga., attending Sol C. Johnson from primary grades through high school. He lettered in 3 sports all through his high school career (Football, Basketball and Baseball).

He entered Tuskegee Institute in the fall of 1977 on a Baseball scholarship under the helm of Coach James "Big Jim" Martin. Ogden was the Batting Champ and also was selected to the First Team All-Conference in 1978-79. He also accomplished other awards in 1979-80 as SIAC Defensive Player of the Year and Tuskegee Fielding Award. In 1980-81 he was selected to the Second Team All-Conference and was also co-Batting Champ in 1980-81. Ogden was part of two SIAC Baseball Championships in 1980 and 1981. During those 4 years he was catcher for the Golden Tigers baseball team.

Ogden graduated from Tuskegee in 1983 with a B. S. degree in Physical Education. He started his career as an Educator, teaching elementary Physical Ed. for 3 years at Burke Elementary in Macon Georgia. In 1988 he returned to his Alma Mater, Sol C. Johnson as Assistant Football Coach. While teaching at Johnson, he served as Assistant Basketball and Baseball Coach. He received his first Head Boys' Basketball Coaching job in 1990 at Sparta High School in Sparta, Georgia. Ogden was then called back to become Head Boys' Basketball Coach at his alma mater, Sol C. Johnson High School. He coached for 16 years, mostly as the head boys' basketball coach.

Ogden received his Master's and Ed. S. Degrees from Cambridge College. He went on to become an Assistant Principal at Alfred E. Beach High School in Savannah, GA. He finally retired as Principal at a night school with the Savannah Chatham County Board of Education.

He supports the Tuskegee University General Fund and is a member of the Tuskegee University National Athletic Association. Ogden is also a proud member of Phi Beta Sigma Inc., Beta Kappa Chapter

Ogden has been married for 35 years to his wife, Patricia. They have two children Brandon and Kelcee, and one granddaughter Bethany. He currently resides in Baxley, Georgia.



Larry D. Bradley

Class of 1985

Larry Bradley a native of Madison, FL, enrolled at Tuskegee University in 1978 on a Track scholarship. As a Golden Strider, he received SIAC honors 4 consecutive years while attending the NCAA Division II Championships 3 consecutive years. He was ranked nationally and on the world list for the 110 High Hurdles & the 400 Meter Hurdles 3 consecutive years. He was a member of the 400 Meter Relay Team which was also recognized on the world list. The highlight of his track tenure was running an Olympic qualifying time in the 110-Meter-High Hurdles in 1980. Brad lettered 3 consecutive years on the Track Team that competed in AL, CA, FL, GA, IL, & TN.

During his academic tenure at Tuskegee, he earned a B.S. degree in Education & a M.S degree in Counseling & Human Development. Brad was a Student Alumni Affairs Representative, Convocations Committee Volunteer, and also a Grad Assistant as a Dorm RA.

Bradley enlisted in the USAF, serving 25 years before retiring as a Master Sergeant. He served in Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Korea, Japan, Germany, Afghanistan, & Guam. After Military life, Brad obtained a position as a Clinical Therapist, specializing in Trauma Therapy & addictions at South County Mental Health Center in Delray, FL. Later he obtained a Senior position at Banyan Health Systems in Miami, Florida. Presently, he works at the Dade County Courts as a Clinical Court Specialist dealing with substance abuse & mental health for the Felony Division in Miami while also serving as a member of the Board of Directors for the Miami Recovery Project. As a therapist, he addresses the psychiatric needs of individuals including Military Vets. Most recently he was named chief of the Medical Staff at Jackson Hospital.

Dr. Gary served on the State Board of Prosthetists and Orthotists, Mayor Steven Reed's transition team, and the Montgomery Covid-19 task force. He serves the Masters program for Prosthetists and Orthotists at Alabama State University. He is on several boards including the Chamber of Commerce, the Montgomery Academy, and Central Alabama Sports Commission. He hosts students for STEM labs, medical lectures, and internships.

Ronald D. Smith

Class of 2011

Ronald Smith, a native of Birmingham Alabama, enrolled at Tuskegee University in 2006, where he played as a Safety; he was a four-year letterman for the Golden Tigers. He helped Tuskegee compile a 51-7 record which included 4 Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championships 2006-2009, and 1 HBCU National Championship 2007. The National Championship team of 2007 was 12-0. The Golden Tigers posted a 26-game winning streak and was 3-0 in Pioneer Bowl play. Smith is one of three TUAHOF to have a National Black College Championship and 4 consecutive SIAC Championship as a player.

Smith holds the 2nd fastest time in the 100m dash in Tuskegee history with a time 10.64 seconds.

In 2010, Smith was rated as one of the best Safeties in NCAA Division II. In 2009, Smith finished 2nd on the team in interceptions, and led the team in 2010. He recorded back-to-back interceptions in the 2009 and 2010 Turkey Day Classic games against Alabama State to seal victories for the Golden Tigers. In 2010, against Texas Southern, he was named MVP. As a stellar starter in 2010, he was named Honorable Mention Player of the Week on two occasions, All-SIAC, All-American, and selected to play in the 2010 HBCU All-Star game. Smith received workouts with the New York Giants and the Jacksonville Jaguars. He also received contract offers from teams in the Arena Football League.

Smith earned his Degree in Accounting from Tuskegee in 2011. He is employed with the Social Security Administration. In 2021, he founded Precise Tax and Accounting and Snacks on Deck Vending. Smith is a member of the Beta Mu Nu chapter of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.

Smith is a member of C.B.F. Ministries International and mentors Parker High School athletes. He contributes to the Eastlake Youth Football Team, conducts a financial literacy presentation for freshman at Tuskegee and consistently makes contributions to Tuskegee.

Smith is the son of Ronald and Lynette Smith. He is married to Jamila Smith and is the father of two children, Jamiya, and Ronald Jr.

HOF NOMINATIONS

Nomination Description: Nominations for induction are accepted thru out the year, all nominations must be submitted prior to **January 1** of the induction year. Inductions are held during the fall of odd years usually during the month of September.

Who can nominate candidate? Nominations can be made by Hall of Fame Members; Tuskegee University Alumni; Tuskegee University Alumni Clubs; any individual knowledgeable about the candidate's achievements; or the candidate.

Rating Category: Nominees for induction into the Tuskegee University Athletic Hall of Fame will be evaluated on the following categories:

- ✓ Made exceptional contributions to Tuskegee sport(s) they are being nominated.
- ✓ Graduate of Tuskegee University or graduate of some other university (4-year degree) for at least 10 years prior to nomination.
- ✓ Direct, consistent and current financial support to Tuskegee University within 5 years prior to the submission of nomination.

Selection Process: TUAHOF Nomination & Selection Committee utilizes a 100 point-based rating system. Nominee must earn points in each category and must have a rating of 89-100 to qualify for induction.

HOF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship Description: TUAHOF Scholarship is available to Tuskegee University student-athletes who demonstrates academic and athletic achievement. Applications available.

Award(s): Two recipients (one female and one male) , \$2500.00 each per year

Selection Criteria: Applicants will be rated and selected based on the following:

- ✓ Full-time sophomore, junior, or senior Tuskegee University student-athlete
- ✓ Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.7 or higher
- ✓ Enrolled at Tuskegee University as a full-time student during the current semester
- ✓ Volunteer at least 25 hours per school year
- ✓ Submit a one-page typewritten essay

Selection Process: Tuskegee Univ. Athletics Academic review applications and select students based on a rubric scoring system.

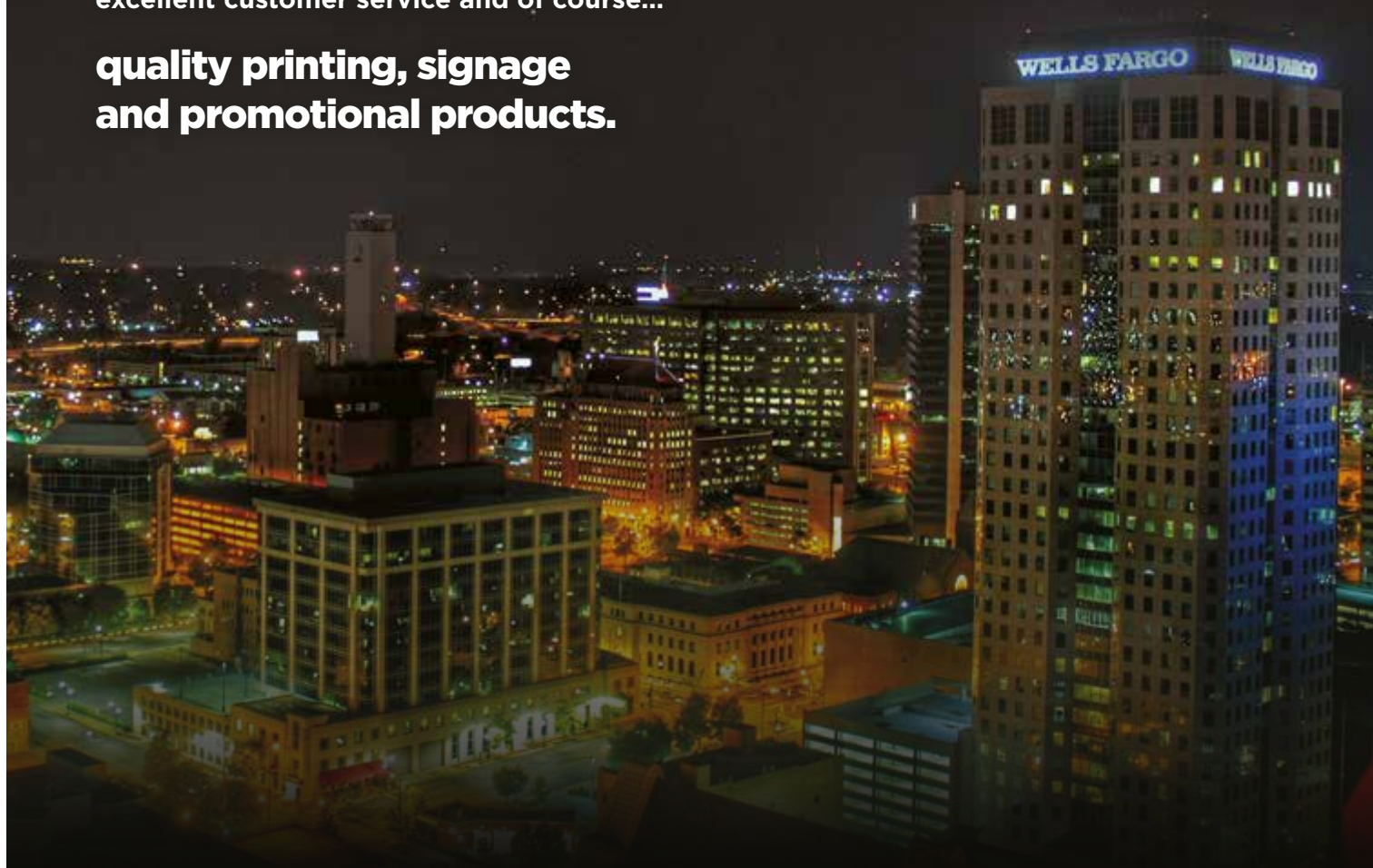
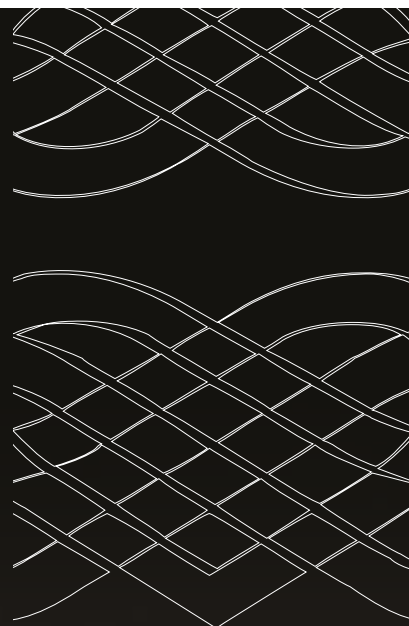
