Alonzo Louis Redmon, Jefferson City, Missouri, played tennis at Tuskegee Institute from 1937 through 1938. He lettered in both football and tennis and was also adjutant in the cadet ROTC program.

Redmon was quarterback on the Tuskegee football team. Sports writers listed him as the toughest little man during his time. He could run and pass. He was also smart on defense. He could take it and he dished it out hard to his opponents.

He is a retired Assistant Director, section of supervision, Missouri State Department of Education. He is a member of the Board of Directors of the Missouri State Easter Seal Society, served on the Mayor's Human Relations Commission, has been a scout master and scout committeeman on the district level and is chairman of the Board of Deacons at the Second Baptist Church.

He has received the Silver Beaver Award in scouting, the Golden Lily Award from the Missouri Easter Seal Society, and was named Mason of the Year for three consecutive years by the Missouri Jurisdiction of Prince Hall Masons.
