Beatrice Franklin Jones, Detroit, Michigan, graduated from Lincoln High School, Port Arthur, Texas. She enrolled at Tuskegee in 1933 in Home Economics. During the four years at Tuskegee, most of her spare time was spent in Warren Logan Hall playing basketball and other sports. She made the varsity basketball team her freshman year and played all four years.

After graduation from Tuskegee she worked at Pickney High School in Carthage, North Carolina as Home Economics and Physical Education Teacher. She organized a girls basketball team and won championships for the county in 1938 and 1939.

She continued her professional experiences with the Birmingham, Alabama School System and later with the Detroit Board of Education from 1950 until her retirement in 1981.

For many years Mrs. Jones received various coveted awards in Food Service from the Michigan Food Service Association, National Home Economics Association and the American School Food Service Association.

With her lovely daughters Alfreda and Roslyn along with her grand-daughter Cheryl Annette, Mrs. Jones continues to be actively involved in community affairs through the Tuskegee Alumni Association and the St. Stephen AME Church.
