ERNEST J. McCAMPBELL Class of 1937

Ernest J. McCampbell, M.D., Shaker Heights, Ohio, was a member of the tennis team at Tuskegee from 1931 through 1937. He won the National Junior Tennis Championship while at Tuskegee, was Intercollegiate Tennis Champion and was Singles Champion of Georgia, Florida and North Carolina.

Dr. McCampbell graduated from Howard University's Medical School in 1943. After an internship in Kansas City, Mo., he entered the U.S. Army. He concluded his military service at the Veteran's Hospital in Tuskegee. He practiced in Williamsburg, Virginia before moving to Cleveland, Ohio where he was one of the founders of the Mt. Pleasant Medical Center where he practiced until his retirement in 1977. He was honored by the Mt. Pleasant Council for 30 years of outstanding community service.
