

FRANK JOHNSON Class of 1953

Frank Johnson, a mighty Golden Tiger, distinguished himself in two sports at Tuskegee from 1949 -1953. In 1953, he was captain of the basketball team and co-captain of the football team. Johnson's prowess on the athletic fields at Tuskegee set the pace for his life work.

Johnson graduated from Tuskegee University in 1953 with a degree in Physical Education. He was commissioned Second Lieutenant, United States Army, retiring after twenty-one years of service. Johnson received the Bronze Star for his service in Vietnam and the Meritorious Service Medal.

Johnson continued his life of service making his marks in the educational arena and retiring again after twenty-one years of outstanding service. He was a school principal.

Dedicated to helping others succeed, Johnson is some of the glue that keeps the Sea-Tac Tuskegee Alumni Association moving. As Vice-President, he has served as co-chair of the Annual Gold Tournament which provides funds to students from the pacific northwest at Tuskegee. He is also a volunteer at the Veterans Hospital, a member of the Knights of Columbus, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Washington State Principals Association and Omega Psi Phi Fraternity.
