G. Marion Britton, Tulsa, Oklahoma, lettered in football, basketball, track and tennis at Tuskegee Institute. He was co-captain of the football team in 1929 and captain of the basketball team in 1928 and 1929. In 1929 he was All-American in football and received Tuskegee's Gold Football Award. He also won the Omega Psi Phi honor award for outstanding student. He won first place in the discus throw three years. He was president of the student council and an honor student at graduation.

After graduation, Britton coached football and taught vocational agriculture for three years. He had a championship football team one year and the championship judging team in vocational agriculture two years. He was a science teacher and head of the science department at Carver Junior High School in Tulsa for 38 years. He now owns and runs a motel in Tulsa. He has been president of the Tulsa Tuskegee Club for 30 years.
