

GEORGE H. (PADDY) ROBINSON, SR. Class of 1943

George H. (Paddy) Robinson Sr., Baltimore, Maryland, played football, basketball and baseball and was on the track team at Tuskegee Institute. He was an All-SIAC and All-American quarterback and president of the "T" Club. He holds pole vault records from the Xavier Relays, Southern University Relays and the Prairie View Relays.

Robinson, a 1943 graudate of Tuskegee Institute, is employed as a supervisor for Bethlehem Steel Corporation and stays active in sports as coach and member of the first outstanding black softball team in Maryland. This team won the state championship in 1963-64.

Robinson was chosen outstanding pitcher and player in the Maryland State Softball Championship and in the East Coast Regional Championship. He is also president of the Service Taxi-Cab Association of Maryland.
