

JOHN FULGHAM Class of 1949

John Fulgham, Montgomery, played football at Tuskegee from 1946 through 1948 and baseball from 1946 through 1949. He won the letter award in both baseball and football and had top honors for batting and homeruns and was rated as one of the best passers and kickers in the SIAC in 1948.

Since graduation, he has coached football, baseball, basketball and track and field. He is athletic director at Carver High School in Montgomery. In his 23 years as a football coach he has a record of 141 wins, 73 losses and 11 ties. He was named coach of the year in 1964 and 1966 and his Carver High School team won the state championship in 1964. He received the Alabama High School Athletic Association and Coaches Association Award for meritorious service.

He is a member of the county, state and national teachers associations. Fulgham is a deacon in the Dexter Avenue Baptist Church and works with the YMCA. Boy's Club and many other civic organizations.
