

MRS. LEILA PERRY GLOVER Class of 1942

Mrs. Leila Perry Glover, Atlanta, Georgia, was a member of the girls basketball, track and field teams at Tuskegee Institute. She was the National A.A.U. champion in the 80 meter hurdles in 1942 and a member of the National A.A.U. 440 relay team which set a world's record.

Mrs. Glover is chairman of the physical education department and coach of girl's varsity sports at H.M. Turner High School in Atlanta where she was named coach of the year and teacher of the year at Turner High School for 1974-75. She was honored by the Atlanta Daily World for her contribution to women's athletics in 1974.

In the 1960's she was a recreational leader during the summers for the Y.M.C.A. and was a track official for the Atlanta Parks Department in 1976-77. She holds a masters degree from Atlanta University.
