Mary Askew Lee, Cleveland, Ohio, was a member of the Tuskegee Institute High School girls track and relay teams in 1928 and 1929. She earned her B.S. degree from Tuskegee in 1934. She was the Trinity Prize winner at Tuskegee for two years and in 1934 was a member of the debate team.

Since leaving Tuskegee she has been a home economics teacher in secondary schools in Cleveland, Ohio and was chairman of the home economics department at East Technical High School in Cleveland for 16 years. She retired from teaching in 1975.

She received her M.S. degree from Wester Reserve University in 1944. She is a member of the 5th District H.E.W. committee, a member of the Cleveland Home Economics Association, the Ohio Home Economics Association and the American Home Economics Association. She is also a member of the Ohio and National Retired Teachers Associations.

Since her retirement she has been active in community service work as a member of the Phyllis Wheatley Association, the East Side Community Planned Parenthood Association, etc.
