OLLIE BELCHER, '36 - participated in football, swimming, tennis, and track while at Tuskegee. He was selected All-Southern in 1928; All-American end in football in 1932; and a member of the All Intercollegiate team in 1931.

Immediately after graduation Belcher served as a referee for several high school games in the Tuskegee area. As a community service, he taught swimming to youth and adults in the Tuskegee community. He was also employed with the U.S. Government Rehabilitation Agency.

His professional career for thirty-five years has been with the Ford Motor Company as a supervisor.
