ROBERT MOORE, Class of 1947, was one of the last triple threat quarterbacks in football. He was among the finest gridmen at Grambling and Tuskegee Institute. As a long distance punter, an accurate passer, and an adept runner, he guided many Tiger teams to victory. He is in the third year with the coaching staff at Tuskegee Institute.

Presently, Mr. Moore is employed at the Tuskegee Veterans Administration Hospital as a Corrective Therapist. His athletic leadership is evident in his having worked with youth in athletics and recreational programs in the Tuskegee area, especially with little league baseball and basketball.

Robert is a member of the NAACP and very active as a member and usher at the St. Joseph Catholic Church. He is known by his friends as a quiet family man and always ready to lend a helping hand to mankind.

Moore and his wife, Mildred, have four children: Robert, Jr.; Keith; Adrean; and Leon. They also have two grandchildren: Tonja and Keith, Jr.
