ROSA LEE TADLOCK, Class of 1931, was born in Boyce, Louisiana, The daughter of Mr. Norman Tadlock and Mrs. Lula Brooks Tadlock. She attended the elementary schools of Boyce, Louisiana and high school at Tuskegee Institute.

While attending Tuskegee Institute High School, Rosa Lee Tadlock was a star on the varsity basketball and a member of the Tuskegee Club.

In 1938, she returned to her home state of Louisiana where she attended Grambling College and majored in teacher education. She received the B. S. degree in 1942. Her M. A. degree in teacher education was received from Bishop College in 1956.

From 1942 until retirement in 1971, Mrs. Tadlock was active as teacher advisor to Gray Boy's Club, advisor to Y-Teen Girls Club, and basketball coach at Spring Ridge Junior High School in Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

Services rendered in other capacities include: Former church school teacher, former secretary of Women's Society of Christian Service, former member of the Caddo Education Association, Louisiana Education Association and the National Education Association.

Present affiliations include: Member of Caddo Retired Teachers Association, the National Retired Teacher Association, the Saint Paul United Methodist Church, member of the church sanctuary choir, teacher in the Vacation Bible School, member of the National Association of Colored Women's Clubs, Inc., assistant secretary of the Shreveport Federation of Colored Women's Club, member of the Mary Church Terrell Club, the Las Fileles Social Club, Grammateus of Beta Omega Sigma Chapter, Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc. and member of the YWCA.
