THOMAS NOBLE SMITH

Thomas Noble Smith, Detroit, Michigan, lettered in football at Tuskegee Institute between 1915 and 1918. He graduated from Tuskegee in 1919.

Smith was also very active in many school activities including plays and as a member of the debate team while at Tuskegee.

After leaving Tuskegee, he established several businesses which included two farms, stores, land and real estate enterprises, while residing in Detroit.

Smith worked at the Ford Motor Company for many years and was one of the first Black supervisors in the Company's blueprint division in Detroit.
